



Dissolving Barriers to Learning

Helping resolve children's learning and behavioural issues

Many children and teenagers find it difficult to engage with learning. The pressure within schools and families to 'get it right' is considerable, often creating more pressure in the child. **Dissolving Barriers to Learning** is a new systemic resource for schools, youth workers and parents who want to identify the roots of a problem and empower the families and children in their care.

These one-day workshops help by creating a simple and comprehensive map of a child's situation. They reveal often hidden relationships between important people and events, stimulating new thinking and insights about ways forward. The workshops are part of an ongoing process to introduce holistic and systemic educational resources to Scotland called **ecl**: 'emotional welfare, creativity & learning'.

How it works

Parents, teachers, youth workers and other professionals form as a group to explore issues on behalf of a child or teenager in their care. Other participants can attend who wish to experience and learn from the approach. There are usually 3 or 4 issues worked on during the day.

The workshops are facilitated by **Stephen Busby** and **Lucy Thomas**.

Stephen leads personal and organisational systemic constellation workshops internationally and in the UK. Lucy is a teacher and is currently developing a range of practical activities which support creativity and well-being in the classroom.
